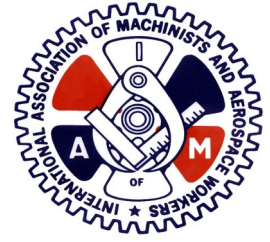

### Employee Assistance Program

The IAM recognizes that there are problems that affect job performance and health.

Dependence on alcohol and other mood altering chemicals, family problems and emotional problems are some examples. The Union believes it is in the interest of the employee, of his/her family, and the employer to provide the troubled employee assistance in dealing with such problems.

An instrument to accomplish this is the Employee Assistance Program (EAP). In general, EAP's are designed for employees and dependents who have personal problems which may affect the employee's job performance. While there may be some differences among employers, affiliated EAP's are voluntary, confidential, professional services which provide evaluations, assessments and referrals, through appropriate resources, for treatment and follow-up care.

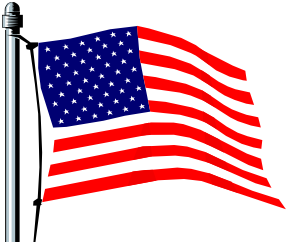

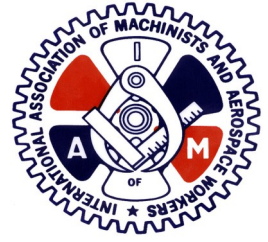
