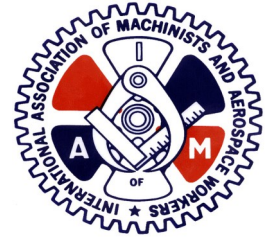

Maintenance Continuing Education classes

We are offering two, four day classes for Maintenance journeymen between apprenticeship classes. These classes will consist of Mechanics, Electric, and Fluid Mechanics. If you are a current journeyman and wish to attend please see your Section Manager to be signed up on the Maintenance Technology Teams page. Below are the dates. Structural Welding Class - 160 hour (4 weeks)

The structural welding course consist of multi-pass single v-groove welds in butt joints in the 2G, 3G, and 4G positions. The theory portions of the course will be taught from Hobarts shielded metal arc welding book (ew369 SMAWA1) and video segments. Written quizzes and destructive testing per WPS - SMAW 002 side bend test.

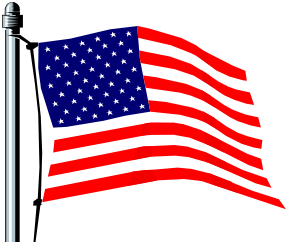
There are 7 Step III bids for the Maintenance Apprenticeship this week:

NOTE:

Per negotiations, Maintenance Apprenticeship bids will be handled the same as a Step III Bid. Bids will be filled by plantwide seniority for the specific areas listed above. If you accept a bid for one of these areas, you will be enrolled into the Maintenance Apprenticeship Program. Upon completion of the program, you will be released as a Journeyman to the section you bid on. Bid rights are restored 12 months after the completion of the Maintenance Apprenticeship Program.

This year the Union picnic will be at Stricker's Grove located at 11490 Hamilton Cleves Road Hamilton, Ohio 45013 on July 14, 2024. Tickets will be available beginning Monday, June 17th – Friday, July 5th at your Union Hall. Tickets must be picked up by the member or their spouse before the deadline.

This event will be at no cost to the members and their families. Due to this being a free event, we ask that you only receive tickets for your immediate family. Each member will be allotted a maximum of six (6) tickets at no cost, any tickets needed over six (6) will be at a cost of \$25 per ticket. This is a way to keep costs within the allotted budget approved by the Membership and allow everyone to benefit. **This event is currently only available to active members and their families.**

Entry into the park includes the following: free parking, 15 rides, 2 roller coasters, free mini-golf, horseshoes, corn-hole, shaded picnic areas, and 2 shelter houses. There will also be free popcorn, cotton candy, sno cones, ice cream, soft drinks and beer.
